TWO DAY WATERING SCHEDULE



Approved by Resolution No. 2022-19
Effective June 14, 2022

Irrigation of all exterior landscaping including, but limited, turf areas, open ground, crops, trees, grass, lawn, ground cover, shrubbery, or decorative plantings using an irrigation system, hose or outdoor potable water faucet shall be allowed only two days a week as follows:

Penalties for Violations of Water usage Restrictions

> First Notice: \$100.00 <
> Second Notice: \$200.00 <
> Third Notice & Subsequent: \$500.00 <
*In addition, persons cited for violations may be required to pay for the installation of one or more of the following: Automatic sprinklers, flow restriction devices, low-flow toilet.

Christmas Tree Collection Program

Gilton Solid Waste Management will be doing curbside collection of Christmas trees after the holiday. Trees will be collected during the first two FULL weeks in January 2023

starting on **January 2nd** and ending on **January 13th.**

1. Trees need to be in front of the house (even if they have alley service)
2. Trees will be collected on customer's GARBAGE collection day
3. Trees need to have all metal stands, lights and ornaments removed (wood stands are OK)
4. Trees should be placed on the street surface next to the curb, but a min of 6 feet away from cars or the cans will be refused.

*Treated trees (flocking, paint, fireproofing) are preferred to be cut up and put in the garbage can, but it is not absolutely required.
